The 57 HAROPA PORT terminals enjoy particularly attractive maritime or river accessibility conditions, multimodal connections and freight services:

- › advantageous transit times for the first north-western European port complex reached by imports
- › maritime accessibility 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, without tidal constraints and at full load (HAROPA PORT I HAVRE)
- › land, river and rail connections to northern Europe and the Mediterranean
- › reception and processing capacities adapted to growing volumes
- › infrastructure located from the entrance to the Channel to the heart of Paris, the 2nd largest consumer market in Europe
- › SPC S)ONE: real-time information and traceability system integrated on the entire Seine axis
- › customs facilitation system.

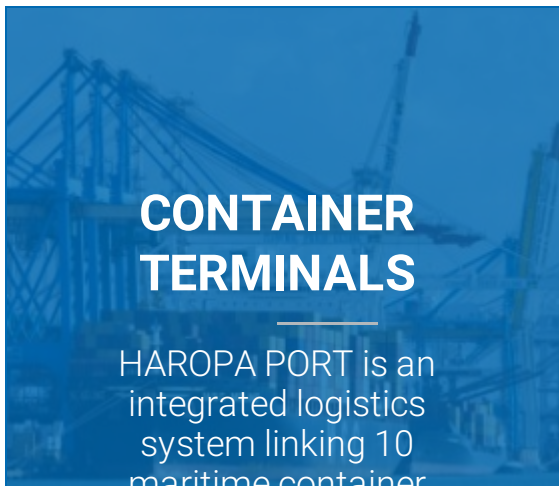
